EDUCATION

Nikunja, (Chris Ebner) born in Basel, Switzerland, studied **at the ART ACADEMY OF BASEL (HKS) from 1975 to 1979**, under the **Swiss Informal Painting Masters** Professors *Werner v. Mutzenbecher, Marcel Schaffner* and additional support by Professor *Franz Fedier*, experimental **graphic techniques** with Professor *Dadi Wirz*, main printer of Surrealist painter *Max Ernst*, receiving his diploma in 1979.

In 1983/84 several hour-long **conversations** with **German Fluxus artist** Professor *Joseph Beuys* (*social sculpture*) on art, spirituality and perception marked the young artist.

In 2003 Nikunja was awarded the **DFG directors course at OXFORD UNIVERSITY**, project-selective and -related one to one meetings with world-renowned documentary movie directors, like *Ross Wilson (UK), Henning Carlson (DK)* and supported by the **grant of the Republic of Geneva**.
