# ART:RE:PUBLIC


*ART:RE:PUBLIC*  
is a non-representative eco-democratic  
academia-forum constituting a new  
democratic independent power. It is accessible  
and at the disposition of all individual or  
collective creators who are able to create a  
performance score (partitura) based on  
*Interactive Matter*.

*ART:RE:PUBLIC*  
invites artists, scientists and concerned citizens into a  
*performance and trans-media art installation score*  
as the non-hierarchical creative environment  
allowing the emergence of new imaginations and  
solutions for the posed social problem.

*Interactive Matter*  
inside of  
*ART:RE:PUBLIC*  
  
creates the condition for progressive emergence  
in the social body and its constitutional conditions.

*ART:RE:PUBLIC*  
is by its nature a nomadic and temporary  
institution taking place and time defined by  
those in need of it around the urgency of the  
theme or problem.

There is no deliberation opposing majority  
and minority but the creation of political,  
cultural,social and societal propositions to  
be submitted to the other independant  
democratic powers and the general public  
based on consensus and common sense.



SAGAR, referring to Eduard Glissant's place of non-place (non-lieu) "Le lieu incontournable du Tout-Monde" and the inherent significance of *the Ocean*, the place of deportation and acted slavehood-body-colonisation and in itself *lieu-non-lieu* by its bio-evolutionary transformation into human blood.

SAGAR is a 22m long, 4,6m wide, 4m high, semi-transparent bio-polymer **stylised whale-(world-mother-body)-sculpture** representing the un-dividable unity and global interconnectivity/interdependency of humanity (**Ubuntu**), transcending darwinism, capitalism, elitism, racism, patriachism at origin and maintenance of colonisation of body, mind and territory.


The **organic futuristic sculpture**, installed at ca.5m mid-height, mounted on **two arches of 20cm diameter bamboo**, an "Emergence of the New Perceptive" between Harvard's architectural forms representing different epochs of thought and conscious, is at once **protective** to passing people and **reaching out to all**. Its surface, a **continuous screen to present solar-autonomous mapped real-time video-projections** from the sculpture's inside, becoming overall **colourful light source**.

Invited artists-, scientists-, poets-, philosophers, scholars, journalists, social collectives **feed live-interventions into running loops**, renewed at their individual discretion, uniting into an **ongoing world-wide "Global Village" post-slavery creolisation program**, accessible by a dedicated virtual platform. The audio-visual connections link to ca. 20 manifestations of scientific, social, societal and artistic expressions of creolisation in progress on all continents: inspirations, initiatives, discourse arising by this process, referring to history, utopias, artistic, social projects under way.

A dedicated geodesic dome-space close to the performance-installation-sculpture serves as **Information Centre (IC)** for the broadcasting participants, documented by video, books, photographs, inviting to interaction, thought-process, events. The IC offers **wireless headphones to connect to the various audio-channels** from the sculpture's video-live/loop-projections.

Post-slavery as progressive creolisation in individual and collective spirit, mind, act, matter: A continuous process SAGAR promotes by an interactive non-hierarchic, intersectional artistic formulation merging art, science and collective progressive conscious, at once physical, virtual and social sculpture. An interactive performance-installation-sculptural as **PROGRESSIVE MEMORIAL** inviting to action and engagement in the PRESENT, freedom of expression and social responsibility.

**'UNTITLED (The Dinner)'** is a DADA inspired art performance by Swiss/French artist Nikunja, performed at the 56th Biennale Di Arte of Venice Collateral Event SOS DADA - THE WORLD IS A MESS in the frame of SALON SUISSE (curated by Juri Steiner and Stefan Zweifel and organised by Swiss Art Fund Pro Helvetia)in collaboration with performers MANNEE (Mauritius/bhojburi), TAFADZWA GWETAI (Zimbabwe/Xlona/Ndebele) and NIKUNJA (Switzerland/baseldytsch) in their respective mother tongues. The video is filmed in one unedited sequence by the spectators, who passed the camera from one to the other, starting with MANNEE at the dinner table. The performance event was curated by **Matteo Bertele, Juri Steiner and Stefan Zweifel**.

**'UNTITLED' (The Dinner) is confronting cultural prejudices and the stress of adaptive behaviour in deep rooted psychic prefixes in the dominant and the dominee of the postcolonial contemporary society alike.**

The original performance is a sequence in Nikunja's movie 'NAMA' of 2008, where he performed together with Namibian actress VEDANTA OTTO. The performance is an interrogation of the cultural and physical content of the 'act of eating' , an act as intimate and fundamental to our identity as the mother tongue. The performance is based on Nikunja's research on "interactivity as a matter", especially cultural interactivity as a raw material, but also physical and psychological interactivity as perception in the multilayered reality of the individual. In this regards the automatic talking takes its importance as the dada-practice used by the three performers, reacting on what impulsion they get by the spoken sounds of the others in a half- aleatoric way.

In the Venice performance the spectators are directly involved by eating their dinner at the same time as the performers, the 'dinner table' of the performers being a sort of physical extension of the common dinner of all. There is an interrogation of 'dinner' as performance and the actual dinner of the spectators. Since the audience was international, the mixture of languages in the court juxtaposed with the conversation at the table.

Further the spectators create the one sequence image recording of the event, again in an aleatoric way, passing the camera from one to the other without a prefixed order. Thus the document is more about the filming spectators than about being a document of the performance.

The physical, cultural and emotional interactions during the performance give room to various art critical, historical and ritual interpretations, reflecting the multilayered and complex reality of perception in the cross cultural meeting.

Dadaism was born 100 years ago in Zurich, Switzerland, also as a reaction on the craziness of the first world war and the then present political and societal reality. The importance is/was to bring about political and societal changes, or at least new impulses for a civilisatory evolution at a time, when the used structures and systems (dominant aristocracy) obviously are/were exploited and not serving men anymore, but that men has to serve these systems.


To break up structures of behaviour to become aware of the underlying realities is essential to evolution.

All artists are present at the 56th Biennale di Arte di Venezia, artist Tafadzwa Gwetai is the assistant curator of the Zimbabwean Pavillon, Nikunja from Reunion Island was selected by Okwui Enwezor with XANADU: THE BASTARD'S DREAM ([www.nikunja.net/](http://www.nikunja.net/) [www.facebook.com/nikunjaxanadu](http://www.facebook.com/nikunjaxanadu)) for which he collaborated with Mauritian performance artist Mannee and Swiss electronic musician Alain Perret (<http://al1music.net/>).

**NIKUNJA**[www.nikunja.net](http://www.nikunja.net)**Short biography (2025)**

Nikunja, born in Basel, Switzerland in 1956, studied **painting** (W.Mutzenbecher, M.Schaffner, F.Fédier), **video-art**, photography and **graphic techniques** (Dadi Wirz) at the ART ACADEMY OF BASEL (HKS) from 1975 on, to obtain a diploma in 1979 and, after having fully concentrated on painting for some early years (selection **50 Junge Schweizer Maler**, KZ Pfäffikon), involved soon in interdisciplinary and cross-media creations involving performance and installation art since 1983 with large innovative realizations on the river Rhine **heart-stream** and at the Art'83 Basel **earth-flag**. He obtained Swiss Federal Art Grants in 1991 and 1991-1993 for ART-EST at the EUROPEAN CULTURAL CENTRE in Krakow, Poland.

Further residencies allowed him to work and exhibit in **Zimbabwe** (1996, Swiss Embassy), **Japan** (1996, Goethe Institute), **Reunion island** (1998, ESBA Le Port; 2000, JAP, Saint Denis; 2007-2009 Centre d'Images ESBA, Le Port; 2013-2014 Theater Leconte de Lisle, Saint Paul), **Netherlands** (2003-2004 Kunst&Komplex, 2005-2006 SKAR atelier, Rotterdam), **Mauritius** (2011 Port Chambly), **Madagascar** (2014, Is'Art Antananarivo).

Since the mid-1990s and the public interactive project **czech flag** (PRAGUE, REPUBLIC SQUARE, 1995), Nikunja's work has been focused on the perception and creative formulation of his artistic/human science conception of **Interactive Matter**, the multi-layered phenomenological field of potentialities existing in-between art users and artists, in-between the medias, materials, temporalities, spaces, historic and cultural dimensions, and how it can be shaped and experienced inside of a temporary autonomous zone (TAZ, Pirate Utopia, Hakim Bey). His trans-media exhibition projects, some of them quite monumental, have been realized internationally at non-commercial institutions of idealistic humanistic value, such as the GOETHE INSTITUTE, KYOTO, JAPAN (**japanese flag**, 1996), the NATIONAL GALLERY BULAWAYO, ZIMBABWE (**nikunja paintings**, 1997), the UNO IN GENEVA, PALAIS DES NATIONS, SALLE DES PAS PERDUES (1997, City of Geneva, Cultural Director Erika Deuber, Patronage UN General Director Vladimir Petrovsky: **oneness world vision reality**), UNESCO Paris, GRAND FOYER, **people begin to fly** for the **50th. Anniversary of the Human Rights Declaration , 150th years of abolition of slavery** (1998, Culture Director Dudu Dien Slave Route project / Patronage Federico Mayor), UNIVERSITY OF GENEVA, (2001, Patronage Professor of Sociology Jean Ziegler / Dr. Raoul Ouedraogo: **the sky above my house**), TENT. MUSEUM WITTE DE WITH, ROTTERDAM (2005, curator, Thomas Meijer zu Schlochtern: **nikunja: fellini now!; testament of the wind** (with performance at MUIDERPOORT THEATRE AMSTERDAM); **babel project**), MUSEUM LEON DIERX, LA RÉUNION (F) (2006/7, curator Laurence Madeline: **art: re: public 1**(Interactive performance-installation with 157 audience participants), IFM INSTITUT FRANÇAIS OF MAURITIUS (2010/2011, curator Elise Mignot: **the borken circle**), 56th VENICE BIENNALE OF CONTEMPORARY ART (2015, Okwui Enwezor: **All The Worlds Futures: xanadu: the bastard's dream**). Recent major works include **timecrystal: kairos chronos logos** (2022, ART BASEL OFF, OLD UNIVERSITY, cur. Roland Fischer, SYMBIONT ART SPACE, Basel) and **interactive matter& art:re:public** (2022 performance lecture SEANSE ART CENTER, OSLO, NORWAY, ITAC6 Biennale). I

Currently Nikunja works on his long-term project of the **Transmedia Art Dome**, a nomadic space with its center **art:re:public** (Reunion Island: **creolization as state of mind**; UNO, Geneva: **split horizons**; Zurich: **alpenglow:after-dada**; Berlin: **water-b(and)its** ), **the greater yjing** ( 729 rain apnt tjings on small metal plates) and **cosmo-clock** an interactive post-digital year clock as well as **sagar** (slavery memorial, Harvard University USA 2027).

After several years of Nikunja's representation by the Cologne based **Gallery Inge Baeker**, and international exhibitions since 1981, Nikunja generally ended his presence on the international art market in 1997 to further exhibit only at institutions and non-commercial art-spaces. Since 2017, Nikunja and young media scholar David Simon-Vermot (University Basel) have written **two theoretical papers** on his concept

of **interactive matter**, published by UNIVERSITIES IN DOHA, QATAR (TASMEEM MEDIA CONFERENCE, 2017) and GOTHENBURG, SWEDEN IS4SI (INTERNATIONAL SCIENCE FOR INFORMATION STUDIES, 2017).

In parallel with Nikunja's exhibition practice, since 2006 he has created and directed experimental performance movies, some of them feature-length, which have been shown at international film festivals and some of which have won awards: **comments on life and death** (2007, 52 ', HD, DV, video sampling, reframing; DURBAN IFF 2007), **nama** (2008, 84 ', HDD, HD, DV, video sampling, reframing; NAMIBIA IFF 2008, CANNES IFF 2008 (CINÉMA DU MONDE), NEW YORK/LOS ANGELES IFVF (2009, 3 awards Pres. Jury Abel Ferrara), BERLIN PERFORMANCE-ART-FESTIVAL **remains-project** 2017 (cur. by Afrotak CyberNomad, Michael Küppers-Adebisi), **cheikh anta diop** (2010, 90 ', HDD, DV, Video Sampling; DAKAR IFF 2010) **xanadu : the bastard's dream** (2015, 92' , HDD, HD, 56TH VENICE BIENNALE OF CONTEMPORARY ART (2015, Okwui Enwezor: **All The Worlds Futures** ).

Since 2006 Nikunja performs the Bengal DILRUBA publicly and created 2019 in Basel the experimental sound project UNCOPPEN SAW together with Mauritian performer MANNEE (vocals, text), French musician MATHIEU SYLVESTRE (electronics, looping, field-recording) and Swiss musician ALAIN PERRET (keyboard, field-recordings, electronics). They recorded their first album **Moïka** at RELIEF STUDIO, Fribourg (CH) and performed at Museum Dada Zurich, Cabaret Voltaire (for Till Velten: Die andere Maria), WURM Basel, UNGEMUETLICH VI (Festival Berlin) since 2023 UNCOPPENSAW publishes 3 tp 4 albums of live recorded comprovisations based on Nikunja's concept of Interactive Matter at the Berlin based music label IAPETUS, Currently Nikunja also works on a compilation of theoretocal texts.

## MANNEE

L'artiste mauricienne MANNEE développe depuis 10 années une langage solitaire de la performance rituelle contemporaine, qui due à ses procès intimes se manifeste principalement dans des video-performances, des installations et des peintures rituelles. Son corps de travail prend racine dans son vécu des rituels traditionnels hindou. Mais elle y relie à travers des formulations contemporaines des forces subtiles perçus dans le Ici et le Maintenant. Ainsi elle choisit des thèmes d'importances actuelles de nos sociétés globales de cultures nomades qui sont l'exile, l'individu et la masse, aise et malaise sociale, intimité et identité; élaborées par des matériaux comme le sang menstruel, la terre, le safran, les pigments, les cheveux, le vernis et la résine et des objets comme des vêtements, des pierres et autres objets portant les traumas sociaux et sociétales de notre civilisation. *Field Recordings and analog synthesizers are the main sources of the sound processed by Mathieu Sylvestre. Noises and natural sounds are interwoven and articulated in electrified sound narratives between aural synesthesia and spatial vibrations.*

*"Listen listen listen to the droning mesmerizing exploding noise of Mathieu Sylvestre as he creates and performs the soundtrack for the art underworld."*

## **Biography :**

Autodidact musician based in Berlin, Germany since 2010, he came from France to Noise Music after 10 years as vocalist and guitarist in rock music field.

With guitars, cello, effect pedals and contact microphones, he first experimented on sounds and noises to work on origin of vibrations by straight analog means.

After guitar noise experiments he developed sound pieces from field recordings and Moog analog synthesizers sound sources.

After hundreds of shows since 2010 in Europe and worldwide this work is constantly enriched by different contexts and places. Mathieu Sylvestre performed in several performance festivals and art events, in art galleries as music performer or as performance artist.

The live electronic sound performances based on improvised patterns have been evolving show after show and highlight boundaries between analog sound textures and the core of electronic vibrations that focuses on bringing noise music a plastic and physical approach.

On the other hand, Mathieu Sylvestre composed sound tracks for visual artists as Wolfgang Petrick or Saskia Edens (CH) and work to provide sound design on live shows in collaboration with Performance artists as Frédéric Krauke (D), NoMass -contemporary dance- (GR), Physical Poets -Butoh- (JP), Non Grata (Est) Diverse Universe Tours from 2012 to 2019 and music/sound design of the art film Symbiosis (Dir.S.Weber - 2024)

He was assistant of visual artist Till Velten between 2015 and 2019 in Basel (CH)

Several collaborating side projects are on the track since 2018 in Berlin with Sonus Eorum (Drone/Noise) Reichenhall (Ambient Noise) and Switzerland with UncoppenSaw (Spoken world Tribal Noise)

Since 2024 Mathieu Sylvestre music is edited on New York City based label ALREALON.


