EDUCATION

Nikunja, (Chris Ebner) born in Basel, Switzerland, studied at the ART ACADEMY OF BASEL (HKS) from 1975 to 1979, under the Swiss Informal Painting Masters Professors Werner v. Mutzenbecher, Marcel Schaffner and additional support by Professor Franz Fedier, experimental graphic techniques with Professor Dadi Wirz, main printer of Surrealist painter Max Ernst, receiving his diploma in 1979.

In 1983/84 several hour-long conversations with German Fluxus artist Professor Joseph Beuys (social sculpture) on art, spirituality and perception marked the young artist.

In 2003 Nikunja was awarded the DFG directors course at OXFORD UNIVERSITY, project-selective and -related one to one meetings with world-renowned documentary movie directors, like Ross Wilson (UK), Henning Carlson (DK) and supported by the grant of the Republic of Geneva.

art:re:public: Art-Science-Activist performance-installation based on Interactive Matter as creative research forum as art process for new democratic expansion staged in the dedicated nomadic Transmedia Art Dome (since 2022)

last supper: transmedia art performance installation dedicated to a new perception of death (since 2025)

the greater yjing: 720 small format square paintings associated to sound frequences installed in a nomadic interactive panorama exhibittion setting exploring the ancient Chinese bone oracle and the relation between individual/collective/cosmic destiny between determination and hasard

transposed heads 2:: reinterpretation of Nikunia's transmedia performance of 2009 inspired by Thomas Mann's novel and the 11th century Indian legend, expanding it to human-humanoid live interaction

MAJOR EXHIBITIONS

After having fully concentrated on painting for some early years with selections into major national exhibitions as 50 Junge Schweizer Maler, CONTEMPORARY ART CENTER ZURICH-PFÄFFIKON and at KUNSTHALLE BASEL (1981), KULTURFABIRK ZURICH-WETZIKON (1983) and solo-exhibitions at KUNSTHALLE PALAZZO LIESTAL (1982) and local galleries, Nikunja involved since 1983 in interdisciplinary and cross-media creations involving performance and installation art with large innovative realizations on the RIVER RHINE **heart-stream** 1983 curated by the City Council of Basel and at the ART'83 BASEL earth-flags large installation leading to the main entrance and a one hour ritual performance gayatri-flow at KULTURFABRIK WETZIKON-ZURICH.

Since the mid-1990s and the public interactive project czech flag (PRAGUE, REPUBLIC SQUARE, 1995), Nikunja's work has been focused on the perception and creative formulation of his artistic/human science conception of Interactive Matter, the multi-layered phenomenological field of potentialities existing in-between art user and artist, in-between the medias, materials, temporalities, spaces, historic and cultural dimensions, and how it can be shaped and experienced inside of a temporary autonomous zone (TAZ, Pirate Utopia, Hakim Bey) and a Split Authority. His trans-media exhibition projects, some of them quite monumental, have been realized internationally at non-commercial institutions of idealistic humanistic value, such as

REPRESENTATION

After several years of Nikunja's representation by the **Cologne** based international GALLERY INGE BAECKER⁴, (Wolf Vostell, Larry Rivers, Howard Kanovitz, etc) and international exhibitions since 1981 including ART'Basel and ART'COLOGNE, Nikunja generally **ended his** presence on the international art market in 1997 to exhibit further on only at non for profit institutions and non-commercial off-spaces, cultivating art practice as a research on the human existential condition free of market-law related corruption.
